The surgery is located in the town centre with onsite parking (The parking spaces are owned and managed by Essex Council). We also have a satellite surgery at North Fambridge on a Monday 1.30-2.30pm located at Fambridge School House, Ferry Road, North Fambridge, Essex CM3 6LS

Under the Health and Social Care Act 2008 (The Care Quality Commission (Registration) Regulations 2009 Part 4), the registering body (The Burnham Surgery) is required to provide to the Care Quality Commission a statement of purpose.

Our Aims and Objectives for all of our regulated activities listed above are:

- We aim to ensure high quality, safe and effective services and environment
- To provide monitored, audited and continually improving healthcare services
- To provide healthcare which is available to a whole population and create a partnership between patient and health profession which ensures mutual respect, holistic care and continuous learning and training.
- The provision of accessible healthcare which is proactive to healthcare changes, efficiency and innovation and development.

- To improve Clinical and Non-clinical risk management
- To reduce risk in specific clinical risk areas and facilities

The registered activities and service types have been agreed by the Burnham Surgery Practice Manager and partners in accordance with CQC guidance. Services are described under registered activity and Service Type

The services provided for the whole of the population registered with The Burnham Surgery for the regulated activities of:

- 1. Treatment of disease, disorder or injury**
- 2. Diagnostic and screening**
- 3. Family Planning**
- 4. Maternity and midwifery**

Are:

- **Routine medical checks and primary medical services NHS relevant prescriptions and medications, including some private prescriptions**
- **Immunisations**, e.g. childhood immunisations
- **Private Medicals** – Doctors will carry out medicals for insurance policies, driving licence renewals and other purposes by appointment only. To arrange a medical and enquire about charges, please contact the office initially.
- **Hearing Tests:** Our healthcare assistant Judy Paine undertakes weekly hearing tests on a Wednesday afternoon.
- **Foreign travel and immunisation**, excluding yellow fever and rabies
- **Respiratory clinic** – The Burnham Surgery has facilities for asthma checks, spirometry and lung function testing, COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disorder) monitoring.
- **Wound care clinics** – these are run by our practice nurses for all types of wound care and removal of stitches.
- **24 hour blood pressure monitoring** –
- **Diabetic clinic** – The Burnham Surgery operates a GP led diabetes clinic each month, to provide ongoing care for our diabetic patients and avoid them having to travel to hospital. We also run regular nurse diabetic clinics.
- **Family planning clinic** – Our family planning clinic is run by our practice nurse and coil insertion/removal by our female GP Dr Collins.
- **Flu vaccination** - At the Burnham Surgery we offer 'at risk' groups the flu vaccine at a certain time each year to protect you against the flu virus.
- **Phlebotomy** – The Burnham Surgery offers early morning clinics for fasting blood tests (from 8.00am) and other blood tests every morning Monday to Friday.
- **Midwifery** - The community midwives hold their own clinics at The Burnham Surgery for patients registered at The Burnham Surgery. The Midwives are managed and based at Mid Essex Hospitals Trust.
- **Minor surgery** - We offer monthly cryotherapy clinic/surgeries for dermatology. The cryotherapy sessions are held with Dr Latif our dermatologist lead.
- **Joint injection Clinic** – We offer a monthly joint injection clinic by Dr Kamlow
- **Ear syringing** The Burnham Surgery has facilities for ear syringing with any of our practice nurses.
- **Specialist dermatology clinic** - We have a GP partner, Dr Latif, with specialist interest in dermatology working within the surgery.
- **Well person/Health checks** – These are carried out by our healthcare assistants
- **Psychiatric clinic** - We hold a weekly clinic on Wednesday afternoons with Dr Onyango from the Mid Essex Linden centre.

- **IAPT** (Improving access to psychological therapies) – We hold weekly clinics with Mr G Hewitt from Mid Essex Hospital Trust
 - **ECG monitoring** - At the Burnham Surgery, we are proud to be one of the GP surgeries in the area which offers ECG Screening and Monitoring,
 - **24 hour ECG's** – Interpretation of results done by Mid Essex Hospitals trust
 - **Cervical screening** - At the Burnham Surgery, our nurses are qualified to carry out cervical screening and tests in the form of cervical smears.
 - **Excel Ultrasound** – We host a fortnightly ultrasound service at the Burnham Surgery for the Dengie locality.
 - **Dietician Clinic** – The Burnham Surgery host a monthly dietician clinic which is run by Mid Essex Hospitals Trust (Dietician Lorraine Hollis)
- Pain Clinic** – The Burnham Surgery are also proud to host a Monthly pain clinic on a Thursday morning run by Mid Essex Hospitals Trust (Dr McCartney)
